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### **This week's health care reform news:**

#### **House Republicans file lawsuit over health care law enforcement**

House Republicans filed a lawsuit last week challenging President Obama over delays in implementation of the Affordable Care Act's employer mandate and the funding of cost-sharing subsidies for low-income Americans.

#### **Other highlights include:**

- **Maine's** governor signals he will appeal a federal court ruling that went against a state proposal to cut back Medicaid eligibility.
- **New Hampshire's** exchange premiums to be 15 percent lower on average next year, analysis shows.
