1095-B Late Notices

Earlier this year, AmeriHealth New Jersey mailed IRS 1095-B tax forms to subscribers who purchased plans individually off-exchange and to subscribers of fully insured group employers. The purpose of the form is for individuals to verify that they had minimum essential health care coverage during the previous calendar year, as required for tax purposes by the Affordable Care Act.

We have recently been made aware that, following the submission of coverage data to the state, the New Jersey Department of Treasury had difficulty processing the information submitted. As a result, some of our customers have received late notices regarding their 1095-B forms.

Currently, AmeriHealth New Jersey is working with Treasury to ensure that no employer will be penalized.

We will continue to share more information on this matter as we receive it.
