SEH transition from United Concordia to AmeriHealth New Jersey dental plans

AmeriHealth New Jersey SEH customers pairing a United Concordia dental plan with their 2015 AmeriHealth New Jersey medical plan will be transitioned to the equivalent AmeriHealth New Jersey dental plan on January 1, 2016.

Most AmeriHealth New Jersey SEH customers will only have to submit a dental application for the transition from an existing United Concordia dental plan to the equivalent AmeriHealth New Jersey dental plan.* Annual accumulators and waiting periods for 2015 will transition to the new AmeriHealth New Jersey plan on January 1, 2016.

If an AmeriHealth New Jersey SEH customer is currently enrolled in a United Concordia dental plan and does not want to transition to an AmeriHealth New Jersey dental plan on January 1, 2016, **they must notify their account executive before November 15, 2015.**

However, SEH customers with a January renewal date must go through the normal renewal process. These groups will have the opportunity to offer a 2016 AmeriHealth New Jersey dental plan alongside their medical plan. This selection can be made in the 2016 group application.

SEH customer communication

All AmeriHealth New Jersey SEH customers will receive notice of the new AmeriHealth New Jersey branded dental plans available in 2016. All SEH customers with renewal dates from February through December will be receiving a [communication](#) in the coming days, explaining the upcoming transition to AmeriHealth New Jersey dental plans.

All SEH customers with a January renewal date will be receiving this [communication](#) in the coming days, explaining the availability of AmeriHealth New Jersey dental plans during their upcoming renewal.

Updated dental ID cards for the SEH transition

Members transitioning to AmeriHealth New Jersey branded dental plans will receive new AmeriHealth New Jersey dental ID cards in December, prior to the transition. We will notify members with a letter regarding the transition before they receive their new cards. Members should begin using their new AmeriHealth New Jersey-branded dental ID card and destroy the old UCD-branded dental ID card on January 1, 2016.
