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## AmeriHealth New Jersey dental updates



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Please be aware of the following AmeriHealth New Jersey dental updates:

### **SEH groups with pediatric-only dental were mistakenly sent ID cards**

Approximately 900 members enrolled in an AmeriHealth New Jersey SEH pediatric-only dental plan were mistakenly sent an AmeriHealth New Jersey dental ID card indicating an incorrect dental plan. Impacted members will receive a [letter](#) communicating this error, and should discard the dental ID card they recently received.

Please note, these members' benefits have not changed. They can continue to use their old UCD ID card or Social Security Number to access care.

As a reminder, all SEH groups enrolled in the pediatric-only dental plan have remained with United Concordia. However, these groups will transition to the AmeriHealth New Jersey-branded pediatric dental plan in March. Customers should expect to see a line item for their pediatric dental plan on their March invoices, available in mid-February. Members will also receive new ID cards next month, and should begin using them on March 1. Communications will be sent to group customers prior to receiving their March invoices, and members prior to receiving their new ID card.

Also, payment for January, February, and March pediatric only dental plan premiums will be due with the group's March 2016 invoice.
