



Dear Valued Partner,

The New York Department of Financial Services (NYDFS) recently released regulations to help covered policyholders who are impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. We are writing to alert you to your notification obligations, as well as the steps MetLife is taking.

As a result of these regulations, MetLife will be notifying policyholders of their rights and obligations. Where MetLife is the recordkeeper for group life, we will be notifying certificate holders directly of their rights and obligations. In addition, for small business customers, defined as NY employers with less than 100 employees, we will be notifying policyholders of their rights related to group life, disability where they conform with NY DBL/PFL, as well as group legal.
