

2022 Open Enrollment is Almost Here!

The GetCoveredNJ Shop and Compare Tool has been Updated with 2022 Plans.

Now, you can review 2022 plan options – more plan options are available in 2022 through more health insurance companies. Although consumers cannot enroll in 2022 coverage until November 1st when Open Enrollment begins, you can help consumers review their coverage options now to find the quality, affordable health coverage option that works for them.

Most Consumers will Be Automatically Renewed – Be Sure to Make 2022 Updates

Similar to last year, Get Covered New Jersey will automatically renew most consumers into 2022 coverage without requiring any consumer action. Consumers will receive notices from GetCoveredNJ by early November with their 2022 eligibility and renewal information and will be able to see their 2022 information in their account starting November 1st. Consumers can make updates to their application or enrollment for 2022 starting November 1st. It is important to inform consumers that if they make any changes to their 2021 coverage after October 14th, they will also have to update their 2022 applications with those same changes after November 1st.

Certification Window is Closing – Complete Training Now

All assisters must complete the annual certification training in order to support consumers starting November 1. Any assister (including agents and brokers) who has not yet completed training should do so now.

Key Open Enrollment Dates

- Now: Updated Shop and Compare Tool
- November 1: Open Enrollment Begins
- December 31: Last Day to Enroll in January 1 Coverage
- January 31: Last Day of Open Enrollment
