Electronically filing ACA information returns requires an <u>application process</u> separate from other electronic filing systems. Additional information about electronic filing of ACA Information Returns is on the <u>Affordable Care Act Information Reporting (AIR) Program</u> page on IRS.gov and in Publications <u>5164</u> and <u>5165</u>. **Applicable large employers that provide employer-sponsored self-insured health coverage to non-employees may use either Forms 1095-B or Form 1095-C to report coverage for those individuals and other family members. This chart applies only for reporting in 2016 for coverage in 2015. In future years, the due dates will be different; see IRS Notice 2016-04 for information about these dates. 					
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
