Week of January 30th

The Time Has Come - Individual Open Enrollment is Ending!

As you are aware, 2017 Open Enrollment runs from 11/1/16 - 1/31/17. January 31st was the last day to enroll in or change a 2017 health plan. After this date, you can enroll or change plans ONLY if you qualify for an SEP (Special Enrollment Period).

Do I qualify for an SEP?

Yes, if you've had certain life events, such as: losing health coverage, moving, getting married, having a baby, or adopting a child.

How long do I have to enroll if I've had an SEP?

You usually have up to 60 days following the event to enroll in a plan. If you miss that window, you have to wait until the next Open Enrollment Period to apply. You can enroll in Medicaid and the Children's Health Insurance Plan (CHIP) any time of year, whether you qualify for a Special Enrollment Period or not. Employer-based plans must provide a special enrollment period of at least 30 days.

Horizon BCBSNJ - Alternate Enrollment Portal Reminder

As a reminder, Horizon has identified some technical issues with the Broker Portal. While they work to resolve this issue, consumer enrollments can be submitted by utilizing the <u>alternate</u> enrollment portal by <u>clicking here</u>.

You will be prompted to enter your National Producer Number (NPN) and can then continue with entering enrollment information for off-exchange enrollees. Horizon - Group Size Info for MLR (Medical Loss Ratio)

Horizon Blue Cross Blue Shield of New Jersey is resuming its survey efforts to collect group-size information for 2015 from fully insured groups with between 35 and 75 enrollees. The group-size information is used to classify groups appropriately under the medical loss ratio

AmeriHealth - Reissuance of ID Cards for Large and Small Group Customers

In February, AmeriHealth will be reissuing ID cards to a population of existing Large and Small group customers. The reason for the reissuance of ID cards is due to a new PO Box for the submission of paper claims. The former PO Box is closed. All paper claims submitted to the former PO Box will be forwarded to the new PO Box, until May 4, 2017. Any paper claims submitted to the former PO Box after this date will not be forward.

NJ DOBI - Advisory Bulletin 17-SEH-01: Guaranteed Renewability When Crossing the 50 Employee Threshold

The purpose of this Advisory Bulletin is to address how the guaranteed renewability requirements set forth in 42 U.S.C. § 300 gg-2 and 45 C.F.R. § 147.106 apply when an employer group size fluctuates from year to year such that the employer is a small employer one year and a large employer another year or is a large employer one year and becomes a small employer during a subsequent year. Generally, an employer has the right to renew the group policy that was issued. However, as discussed in this Advisory Bulletin, there are exceptions to that right. This Advisory Bulletin also addresses the consequences of the definition of Small Employer as operative January 1, 2017.

Since small employer plans issued through the SHOP are administered by the SHOP, the guidance in this Advisory Bulletin does not address small employer plans purchased through the SHOP.

As a reminder, New York small groups that currently only offer an Oxford Health Plans (NY), Inc. (OHP) HMO plan need to take action to purchase a new Oxford Health Insurance, Inc. (OHI) policy before their current OHP plan ends. These groups did not receive a renewal package from Oxford and need to apply as a new group.
