New Jersey Law Update

New Jersey Minimum Wage Increases

On January 1, 2022, the minimum wage for most employers in New Jersey will increase to \$13.00 per hour. For seasonal and small employers (those with five or fewer employees), the minimum wage will increase to \$11.90 per hour. Agricultural employers must pay at least \$11.05 per hour. Employees who provide direct care at a long-term care facility will be entitled to \$16 per hour.

The minimum base wage for tipped employees will increase to \$5.13 per hour.
