Tax Season Readiness Announcements

- Tax season is here! This year, the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) will not accept electronically filed tax returns where the taxpayer does not address the health coverage requirements of the <u>Affordable Care Act</u>. - Help consumers who enrolled in coverage through the Health
 Insurance Marketplaces and received advance payments of the
 premium tax credit (APTC) understand the <u>Form 1095-A</u> that they
 receive from the Marketplace.
