October 30, 2017**Waterbury Hospital's Network Participation**

As part of our commitment to provide your clients and their plan participants with access to comprehensive and affordable health care services, we're currently negotiating a new agreement with Waterbury Hospital in Waterbury, Connecticut.

What this means for your clients.

Our current agreement with Waterbury Hospital, which only affects Oxford commercial products, will terminate on Dec. 1, 2017 and a new agreement has not yet been reached.

If we cannot reach a new agreement, we will have Transitional Care guidelines in place so members eligible for Transitional Care and who have scheduled or ongoing medical treatments at Waterbury Hospital will continue to get care as appropriate after Waterbury Hospital is terminated.
