IRS 6055 Group Data Collection Process Announced for New Business



UnitedHealthcare is required by the Affordable Care Act 6055 and 6056 reporting to furnish Form 1095-B to responsible individuals that we insure and submit reports to the IRS that verify the accuracy of that information. View the process to be used by new business clients for submitting the required 1095-B information.

■ PCORI Notice Scheduled for All Savers® Clients:

Self-funded plan sponsors must file a Form 720 and pay the Patient-Centered Outcomes Research Institute (PCORI) fee directly to the IRS by July 31 of the calendar year following the last day of the plan year. In mid-June, All Savers will mail its membership report to groups who have plan years ending in 2016 for filing Form 720. [Learn more](#)
